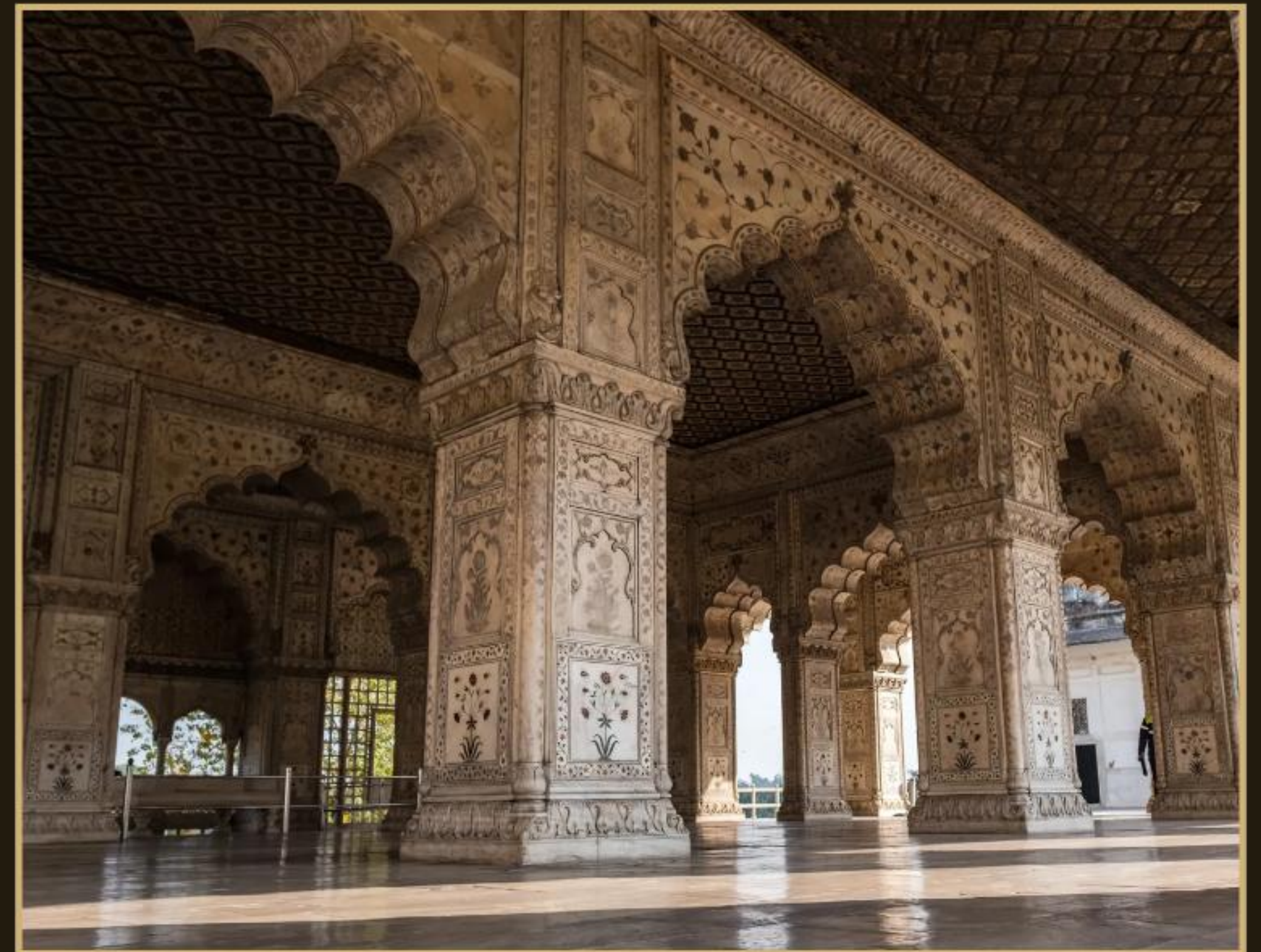

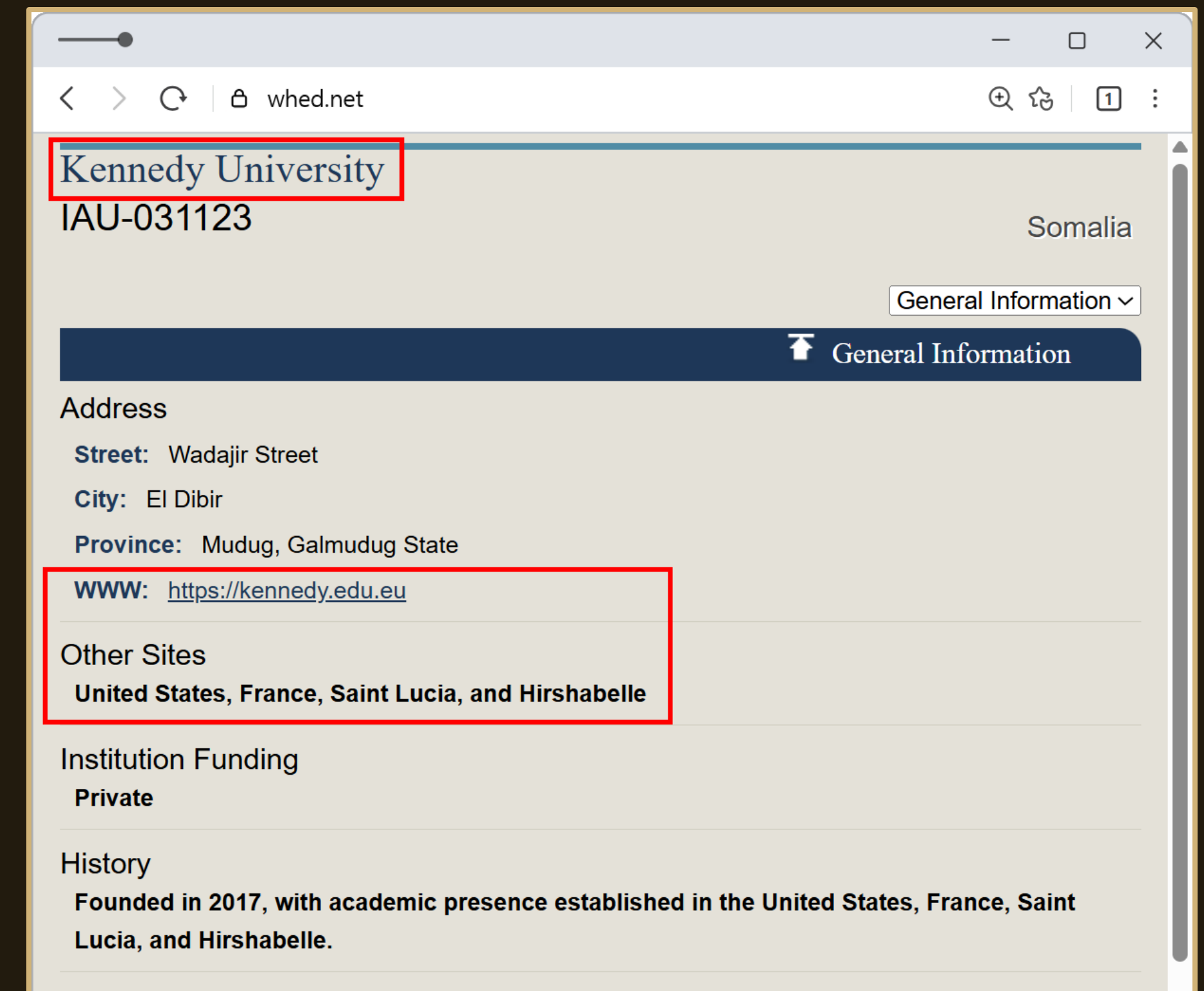

Uses WHED to verify applicant degrees.

Accepts degrees only from WHED-listed schools.

Recognizes degrees only from WHED institutions.



Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO)

Considers only WHED-recognized degrees.

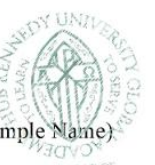
